1.1 Techno Instruments (We/Us) are committed to ensuring the security and protection of personal information that we process and provide. Adhering to this privacy statement we have setup guidelines that primarily define practices that are intended to collect/share/process personal information. This privacy statement hence is intended to inform you of the ways we use the personal information that you choose to provide us, through our website.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU

2.1 We will collect and process all or some of the following personal information about you via

2.1.1 Personal information that you provide to us, such as when using the contact form, careers form, or any subscription forms on our website, including your name, email address, location, and other contact details.

2.1.2 Incoming Contact that you make with us, through other sources such as Phone, Skype, Direct Email, etc. we will typically keep a record of that correspondence.

2.1.3 Surveys that we may request you to complete for research purposes. We shall collect the information provided in the completed survey.

2.1.4 The Website wherein details of your visits to the website and information collected through cookies and other tracking technologies including, but not limited to, your IP address and domain name, your browser version and operating system, location data, traffic data, weblogs, and other communication data, and the resources that you access.

HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

3.1 This section defines the purposes for which we use personal information that we collect via our website and, in compliance with our obligations under the IT Act, 2000, identify the “legal grounds” on which we rely to process the information.

3.2 The Information Technology Act, 2000 (India) allows companies to process personal information only when the processing is permitted by the specific “legal grounds” set out in the law.

3.3 Please note that in addition to the disclosures we have identified below, in some circumstances we will also disclose personal information to service providers, contractors, agents, and affiliates of Techno Instruments that perform activities described in this notice on our behalf.

3.3.1 For transparent and effective communications and business operations: This includes responding to your concerns, queries, feedback, requests, etc or to carry out any obligations arising from any agreements agreed upon between you and us, wherein under some circumstances may include passing your data to third parties such as our advisors/consultants (legal, financial, business or others), contractors, or execution agents.

3.3.2 Why we do this: To ensure the efficiency of the contract performance and compliance with legitimate interests that allow us to perform our responsibilities/obligations and provide our services to you.

3.3.2.1 Access to promotional materials: To provide you access to updates, promotions, or other relevant information where you have chosen to receive these. 3.3.3.1 Research and Development: We analyze your personal information so that we can understand your requirements better. This process helps you, our other clients and us to better understand our business and services.

3.3.4.1 Why we do this: Genuine policy to improve our business and services for you.

3.3.5 Supervision and record-keeping: To monitor and keep a record of concerns, queries, and transactions to maintain service quality, comply with standard procedures and to effectively manage conflicts if any.

3.3.5.1 Why we do this: To ensure that the quality and legality of our services remain compliant with legal obligations, claims and legitimate interests.

3.3.6 Keeping you informed: To notify you about changes to our services and business.

3.3.6.1 Why we do this: Genuine policy to ensure that you are aware of changes made to our services and business.

3.3.7 Accuracy and relevance of our website content: To ensure that the content from our website is presented in the most effective and transparent manner for you, and your device which may include passing your data to business partners, suppliers and/or service providers.

3.3.7.1 Why we do this: Genuine policy defined to allow us to provide you with content/services on our website and for contract performance as well.

3.3.8 Legal or regulatory obligations: We process your personal information to comply with our regulatory requirements or as part of dialogue with our regulators as applicable which may include disclosing your personal information to third parties, the

court service, regulators and/or law enforcement agencies in connection with inquiries, proceedings or investigations by such parties anywhere in the world or where compelled to do so. Where permitted, we will direct any such request to you or notify you before responding unless to do so would prejudice the prevention or detection of a crime.

4.1 SECURITY OVER THE WORLDWIDE WEB

4.2 DATA STORAGE LIMITS

4.2.1 We will retain your stored personal information for as long as necessary for purposes for which the data was originally collected or for relevant purposes linked to it. We may also retain your personal information for longer than when we may have to comply with legal or regulatory requirements. The retention period for your data would be considered based on the business need, or your tenure of the contract with us. When your personal information is no longer needed it is either encrypted to prevent access or securely destroyed in accordance with our internal standard policies.
